Moral: Greed destroys your resource.

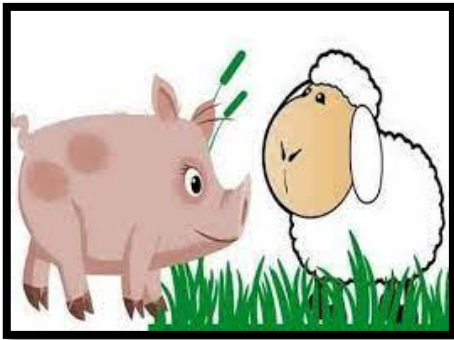
3. Two Friends and the Bear
