### The Dedication of Ekalavya

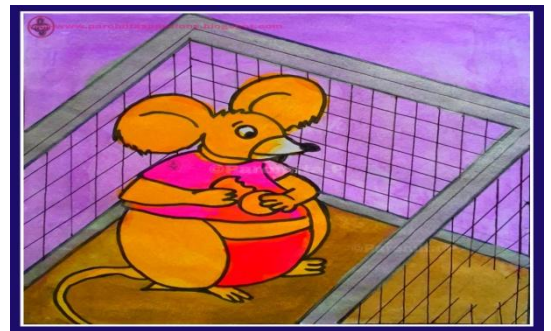
